SURRON WARRANTY CONDITIONS

1. CONDITION OF WARRANTY

The warranty applies only if the motorcycle has been operated and maintained in accordance with the owner's manual or other Surron literature delivered with the motorcycle. This warranty is void if the OWNER'S REGISTRATION/PRE-DELIVERY INSPECTION FORM has not been completed in full and entered into the Surron dealer system by the selling dealer within 48 hours of purchase.

2. PERIOD OF WARRANTY FOR SURRON MOTORCYCLES

2.1. SURRON BIKES USED IN COMPETITION:

Coverage: Chassis/Swingarm/Motor/Controller Non-Service items*

Duration: 30 days from date of purchase. *

Limitations: This warranty is not transferable and applies to the original purchaser

only.

Applies to: LBX, L1E, LBS, ULTRA BEE, STORM BEE

2.2. SURRON BIKES NOT USED IN COMPETITION:

Coverage: Chassis/Swingarm/Motor/Controller, Non-Service Items. **Duration:** 12 months, Non-Service Items 12 Months. Subject to service

schedule. Excludes items*

Limitations: This warranty is not transferable and applies to the original purchaser

only.

Applies to: LBX, L1E, LBS, ULTRA BEE, STORM BEE

*Any Surron motorcycle utilized commercially in connection with generating income and/or is commercially licensed or tagged (e.g., Rental) during the warranty period will be covered for 30 days from the date of purchase.

*The warranty period is effective on the date of purchase by the original purchaser and remains in effect only as stated above.

3. PARTS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

This warranty covers only the parts stated. No other components of the motorcycle are covered by any warranty, expressed, or implied and are sold "as is". The frame is defined under this warranty as the main frame only of the motorcycle. The motor is defined under this warranty as parts, which are housed within the frame. In addition to the motor, the warranty covers the ignition system/electrics. Both front and rear suspension will not be covered under warranty if the suspension is bent or show signs of excessive force. Surron motorcycles UK will repair or replace, at its option, any of these parts that are found to be defective in material or workmanship subject to the limitations of this warranty.

4. WARRANTY LABOUR COVERAGE

Labour to replace parts that are covered in warranty, which are found to be defective in material or workmanship, is no charge to the original purchaser. Warranty repairs must be done only with the authorization of Surron motorcycles UK, Labour costs to replace any parts without authorization from Surron motorcycles UK, or any other parts not covered in the Surron motorcycles UK warranty are not covered.

5. GENERAL EXCLUSIONS FROM WARRANTY

This warranty does not cover any failures resulting from, or caused by:

- 1. Lack of proper maintenance.
- 2. Modification, alterations, and installation of parts that are not genuine Surron parts or supplied as original equipment.
- 3. Damages due to accident, collision, abuse, or neglect, including the use of high-pressure/Jet washers as stated in service documentation.
- 4. Normal wear components, including, but not limited to, the following: all bearings, all seals, transmission gear engagement, final-drive chain and sprockets, brake components, suspension valving.
- 5. Misuse, such as, but not limited to, non-suitable lubricants, altering the electronic control system/wiring, non-genuine owner installed replacement parts.

6. OWNER RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. Owner is responsible for the costs of maintenance to the motorcycle including service at scheduled intervals. Failures caused directly by lack of maintenance or improper maintenance will void the warranty.
- 2. If warranty repairs are needed, they must be performed by an authorized Surron Motorcycles dealership. The owner may be asked to provide the following documentation of proper maintenance: a maintenance record which displays the date of service and service work performed, copies of repair orders/ receipts.
- 3. Return the Surron motorcycle to an authorized Surron motorcycle dealer within ten (10) days after discovery of any defective parts. Your Surron Motorcycles dealer should initially determine if the Surron component(s) in question are to be submitted to Surron Motorcycles UK for evaluation. All warranty work must be performed by an authorized Surron Motorcycles dealer.
- 4. Surron Motorcycles UK are not responsible for the transport nor the recuperation of transport costs between the owner and the dealer.
- 5. Surron Motorcycles UK does not authorize any company or person to create a liability or any warranty obligation on its own behalf. Surron Motorcycles UK in its sole discretion will make the final disposition of any component(s) submitted for warranty evaluation. All parts and components returned to Surron Motorcycles UK and replaced under this warranty shall become the property of Surron Motorcycles UK.

7. LIMITATIONS ON WARRANTY

The warranty described in this document is the only warranty that applies to your motorcycle. Surron Motorcycles UK makes no other warranty or guarantee of any kind, expressed or implied. No implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose or any purpose, is applicable to any product sold by Surron Motorcycles UK. The buyer and all other parties who contract with Surron Motorcycles UK, hereby specifically and knowledgeably waive any and all warranties, expressed or implied. Also excluded from this warranty are any incidental or consequential damages including loss of use. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, the contents stated herein are subject to change without prior notice.

Important Considerations:

The service schedule is a minimal guide, machines used in harsh environments and on severe terrain may require more maintenance as and when required. As with any enduro machine, daily owner checks and the correct method of use are essential to ensure the longevity of your machine for many years to come. Sur-ron have taken great care in the selection of materials and manufacturing techniques to provide its customers with a quality cosmetic appearance allied to durability. Please be aware that any work on the high voltage systems MUST be carried out by a qualified dealer carrying at least a Hybrid Electric Vehicle qualification.

As per the owner's manual please always check the machine before and after use. Particular attention should be placed on both primary belt and chain tension, lubrication, essential nut and bolt torque levels, tyre pressures, spoke tension and steering bearings.

Before disconnecting or reconnecting the battery – ALWAYS switch off the master fuse switch, situated at the front of the battery compartment from the seated position.

Always get in the habit of recharging your battery after a ride, never leave the battery at a low charge level for a prolonged period, refer to the operator's manual for longer storage advice.

<u>Never use a high-pressure/jet washer</u> system to clean your machine, a gentle low-pressure hose with cloth/brush is recommended. Always re grease under the fork dustcovers monthly to ensure smooth operation.
